ORDINANCE NO. 03-2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATION FOR THE ORANGE TOWNSHIP RECYCLING CENTER; AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Orange Township Board of Supervisors, in order to promote the health, maintenance, and welfare of the citizens of Orange Township, hereby establishes reasonable rules and regulations to maintain the order, cleanliness, and appearance of the Orange Township Recycling Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Orange Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 101. Rules

- 1. No rubbish/items are to be left on the ground on or about the Recycling Center area.
- 2. Persons using the Center must abide by the signage and place the correct rubbish/items in the correct bin(s) as indicated.
- The Recycling Center is for the use of Orange Township, Mount Pleasant Township, and Orangeville Borough residents only.
- 4. Cardboard and boxes must be broken down before such are placed in the bin(s).

Section 102. Enforcement Remedies

Violations of this Ordinance shall be enforced by action brought before a District Justice in the same manner as provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. Violations of this Ordinance may result in fines not

to exceed \$1,000.00 per violation and imprisonment up to 90 days for each violation.

The Code Enforcement Officer of Orange Township shall make the initial determination of violation of the Ordinance, serve the notice of violation, and file a summary citation alleging violations of this Ordinance.
