**ORDINANCE NO. 2001-03**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED  
ON KLINE ROAD FROM GREEN CREEK ROAD TO  
BOWMAN MILL ROAD**

WHEREAS, Section 3362(a)(2) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 3362, establishes a maximum speed limit of 55 miles per hour for rural roads unless a reduced speed limit is established by the government entity having jurisdiction over said roads; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Orange Township has caused a traffic study to be performed on Kline Road which indicates that the existing maximum speed limit of 55 miles per hour is excessive and unsafe, and that reduced maximum speed limits would be more appropriate based upon the condition of the road, and the nature and volume of traffic using the road; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Orange Township has determined that reducing the maximum speed limit on Kline Road as provided hereafter will promote the public safety and general welfare of the residents of Orange Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Orange Township hereby ORDAINS AND ENACTS that the maximum speed limit on Kline Road for a distance of 2.2 miles from Green Creek Road to Bowman Mill Road shall be 30 miles per hour.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment pursuant to Section 1601(a) of the Second Class Township Code.
